MILDURA BOWLS CLUB ENJOYS NEW SHELTERS THANKS TO FEDERAL FUNDING

New shelters will be shading bowlers at the Mildura Bowls Club this summer after the club received \$23,500 from the Federal Government's Department of Veterans Affairs.

Along with a \$20,000 contribution from the Victorian Government's Community Shade Grants Program the club have been able to build two state of the art colourbond steel shade shelters along the Cureton Ave frontage, including a concrete pathway along the entire boundary and comfortable aluminium seating.

Federal Member for Mallee Andrew Broad visited the bowls club today to check out the final product.

"These shades are going to provide much needed relief for our local bowlers once summer comes around, not only are they sun smart but the shades are doing a great deal for the safety of local players too," he said.

"I'm told this project has truly been a team effort led by the Board of the Mildura Bowls Club, plenty of willing volunteers and contract workers plus support from both levels of government."

"I'm happy to see a great outcome from the Federal Government's investment, and something that will be used by the bowling community here in Mildura for years to come."
