CAPITAL GRANTS PROGRAM DELIVERS FOR LOCAL SCHOOL PROJECTS

Three new school projects will take place at schools in Horsham and Red Cliffs thanks to local success under the Capital Grants Program.

Mr Broad has welcomed the news, with more than \$4 million to be shared between Holy Trinity Lutheran School and St Brigid's College in Horsham, and St Joseph's School in Red Cliffs.

"The Capital Grants Program aims to provide and improve school capital infrastructure, particularly for students and schools at an educational disadvantage," Mr Broad said.

"We're now going to see three new projects delivering better student and staff facilities supporting better education across our patch."

In Red Cliffs, St Joseph's School will receive commonwealth funding of \$920,000 to go toward the refurbishment of general learning and administration areas and associated spaces. Holy Trinity Lutheran School will receive \$1,670,000 in funding to help with the construction of a two storey senior secondary building. Finally, St Brigid's College will receive \$1,700,000 in funding to contribute to the construction of specialist learning areas and student amenities.

"We need to ensure that our regional schools, students and teachers are all supported along the journey to better education."
