UPGRADES AT THE HORSHAM CROQUET CLUB UNDER THE STRONGER COMMUNITIES PROGRAM

The Horsham Croquet Club has been successful in their application for a grant to upgrade fencing on the local croquet greens.

Federal Member for Mallee, Andrew Broad said the club will receive \$4,397 under the Federal Governments Stronger Communities Program to go toward the project, improving safety for both participants and spectators.

“This grant is going help the club remove the pine log barrier, a current safety hazard, and help put brand new fencing in place, it’ll have a completely new look,” he said.

“The new upgrade is set to increase local community participation at the club and get more people involved and active.”

The total project cost is estimated at \$9,674 with the current low pine log barrier removed and steel H-Rail fencing placed around the greens instead.

Club members are hoping the new look fencing will enhance the appearance of the croquet facilities and increase membership.
