CASH FLOWS TO SEE WATER FLOW AT OUYEN LAKE.

Federal Member for Mallee Andrew Broad has welcomed news that a Deed of Agreement has been signed for the long awaited Ouyen Lake project to go ahead.

The project will receive \$674,000 in funding from The Australian Government and will see a recreational lake built including a gravel road, footpath, boat ramp, BBQ area, toilet amenity block, playground, landscaping and lighting.

Mr Broad said the signing of the contract marked an important day for the Ouyen community.

“This project will be a major boost for the local community and for regional tourism in our patch,” he said.

“Children and families are going to be able to go to the lake for a swim and take part in water sports, tourists can pull up their caravan – it’s something the Ouyen community has never been able to experience before.”

The Ouyen Lake project is a partnership between the Australian Government, and the Ouyen community.

Mr Broad commended Ouyen Inc for their delivery of the project.

The completion date of the project is 31 July 2019.
