ANOTHER OVERTAKING LANE UNDERWAY ON THE CALDER

Federal Member for Mallee, Andrew Broad MP said he was very pleased to see work underway on the Calder Hwy for a third overtaking lane between Ouyen and Red Cliffs while he was on the road this week.

The lane is the third of four to be funded by the Federal Government to make the Calder Hwy a safer and quicker drive for local motorists.

“It is a notorious spot on the highway to get stuck behind a line-up of trucks and cars with no chance to overtake, slowly but surely I’m working hard to address this issue for local drivers,” Mr Broad said.

“In regional communities our roads are our lifeline, many people live out of town and travel this stretch every day for work or on the weekends for sport – it is an absolute priority that our roads are safe.”

The upgrade is part of the Turnbull Governments \$10 million investment into improving the Calder Hwy with new overtaking lanes as well as upgraded and new rest areas
